How to Prep for a MAD-learn Internship Interview

✓ KNOW YOURSELF

- Know your strengths, skills, interests, and goals.
- Be ready to explain why you're a great fit.
- Have examples of your experience and accomplishments.

✓ KNOW MAD-learn

- Review the internship program and how it works.
- Learn about MAD-learn's mission and what we do.
- Explore our website and social media.
- Prepare thoughtful questions.

✓ SHOW UP READY

- Practice your answers but don't memorize them.
- Log in 5 minutes early and test your audio/video.
- Dress appropriately and choose a quiet, distraction-free space.
- Be friendly, confident, and engaged.

✓ FINISH STRONG

- Listen carefully and keep your answers focused.
- Ask thoughtful questions and find out about next steps.
- Send a Thank You note after the interview.
